REASON FOR PLANTING

In the last 200 years, Leeward Haleakalā has been greatly transformed by burning, grazing, and invasion by nonnative plant species. As a result, much of the area’s original native shrub and understory has been destroyed and replaced largely by introduced grasses and nonnative trees. Efforts are underway to reestablish some of Hawaii’s most diverse and culturally significant native habitats.



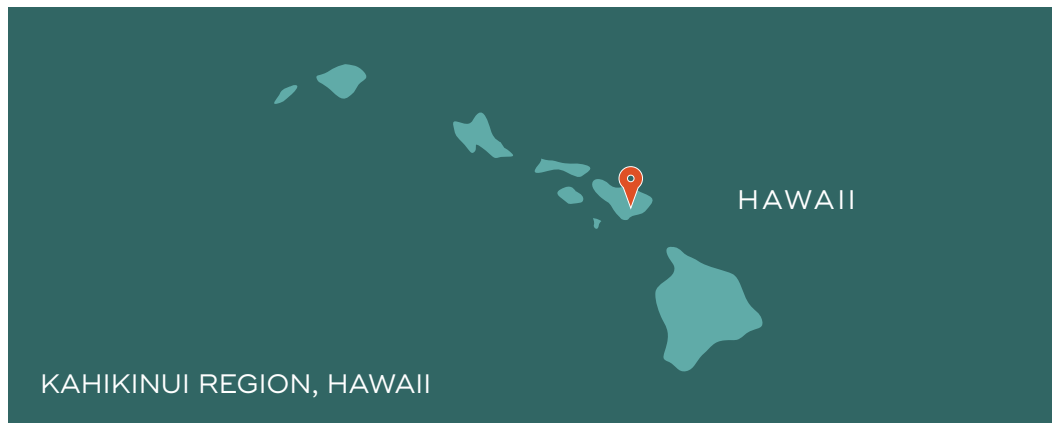
Reestablishing native trees and shrubs in the region to maintain natural biodiversity
