PROJECT PROFILE: 2019

Willamette River Basin, Oregon

REASON FOR PLANTING

The iconic Willamette River is 187 miles in length, drains a 11,478-square-mile area (12% of Oregon's landscape), and serves as a major tributary of the Columbia River. Tree planting efforts here will protect the watershed area of a basin that is home to two-thirds of Oregon's population and generates 75% of its economic output.



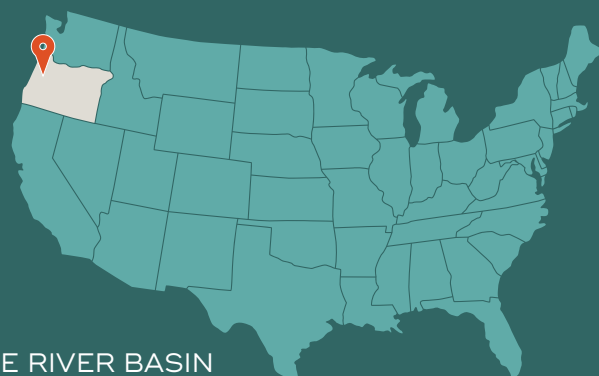
Reestablishing riparian forests throughout the Willamette Basin to ensure clean drinking water and healthier waterways



Improving water quality and habitat for aquatic wildlife including Chinook salmon, steelhead, and lamprey



Providing critical habitat for the vast array of birds and other wildlife that rely on this area
