# Coconino National Forest, Arizona

## REASON FOR PLANTING

In 2016, all fire scars within the Coconino National Forest were mapped, and it was discovered that areas burned by fires in 1996 and 1962 had not yet regenerated. Ponderosa pine planting is critical in these areas to help restore the landscape to its original state.
