Klamath National Forest, California

REASON FOR PLANTING

Multiple fires over the last five years have taken their toll on Klamath National Forest, leaving large swaths of charred landscape with little to no seed sources for natural regeneration. Affected areas include critical habitat for the northern spotted owl as well as river habitat for threatened and endangered Coho Salmon.

Providing slope stability and a reduction in potential long-term erosion
