REASON FOR PLANTING

Encompassing one of the most ecologically diverse areas in the United States, Monongahela National Forest is in need of restoration. Areas of the forest were mined for coal in the 1970s and are suffering from lack of tree cover. Reforestation efforts will help to revitalize the damaged red spruce ecosystem that is key to the health of this landscape.
