REASON FOR PLANTING

Having acquired a parcel of land from timber companies, the U.S. Forest Service is looking to develop stands of locally adapted shortleaf pine in areas that have been unable to regenerate naturally. Bolstering the tree cover in this area will help to maintain forest health and provide habitat for wildlife.
