REASON FOR PLANTING

This effort spans seven different locations, all focused on longleaf pine restoration. The goal of much of the planting is to not only reestablish longleaf pine stands in the area but also provide critical habitat for a keystone species – the gopher tortoise – and other threatened and endangered species.
